# Levels and Benefits

## ▲ Commonwealth

**Annual fee \$500**

**Maximum number of employees covered 15**

**BENEFITS** Each employee member receives the full benefits of a Mass Audubon **Family membership**. Both new and renewing corporate members are **recognized annually** in Mass Audubon's *Connections* member newsletter.

## ▲ Premier

**Annual fee \$1,000**

**Maximum number of employees covered 25**

**BENEFITS** In addition to the benefits at the Commonwealth level, the honorarium fee is waived for one of our team of **professional field staff** to speak at an event at your corporate site.

## ▲ Executive

**Annual fee \$2,500**

**Maximum number of employees covered 100**

**BENEFITS** In addition to the benefits at the Premier level, we will arrange a **special nature program, walk, other activity** at one of our wildlife sanctuaries for your employee members. **Executive** corporate members are also recognized in Mass Audubon's **Annual Report**.

## ▲ Presidential

**Annual fee \$5,000**

**Maximum number of employees covered 200**
