Explanation of the Environmental Roll Call Votes for the House of Representatives

12/7/93 H.3033 SLAPP

This was a vote for passage of H.3033, the so-called "SLAPP bill," by the House of Representatives. Strategic Lawsuits Against Public Participation (SLAPP) are typically filed by corporations and real estate developers. SLAPP suits are designed to harass and retaliate against citizens for speaking up at public hearings or signing a petition. Because of the suit, citizens spend thousands of dollars defending themselves against frivolous lawsuits that are thrown out of court. H. 3033 gives victims of SLAPP suits procedural advantages to obtain dismissal of the suit and reimbursement for attorney's fees. A "yes" vote was for the environment.

5/2/94 H. 1520 SLAPP

This was a vote to substitute a weakened version of H. 1520, the so-called "SLAPP bill." A "no" vote was for the environment.

Explanation of the Environmental Roll Call Votes for the Senate

5/12/93 S. 1620 RIVERS

This was a vote for passage of S. 1620, the Massachusetts Rivers Protection Act. This bill establishes a 150-foot buffer on both sides of most rivers and streams in the state. Development in this buffer is restricted. A "yes" vote was for the environment.

7/8/93 H. 910 PHOSPHATES

This was a vote to substitute an amended version of H. 910, the so-called "Phosphate bill." This bill prohibits the sale of certain cleansing products containing phosphorus to reduce pollution from the use of these products. A "yes" vote was for the environment.

5/16/94 S. 1588 RIVERS

This was a vote to amend a section of the Rivers Bill, S. 1588, concerning municipal development and river protection plans. A "yes" vote was for the environment.
