Broad Meadow Brook's 400+ acre sanctuary is home to a vast array of wildlife, including over 160 bird species and 78 types of butterflies.

Conveniently located on the outskirts of Worcester, we are minutes from the Mass Pike, Routes 290, 122, 146, 20, and 9.

The WRTA Bus #22 Millbury stops in front of our Visitor Center.

Mass Audubon is the largest conservation organization in New England, working to protect the nature of Massachusetts for people and wildlife. Our statewide network of 45 wildlife sanctuaries welcomes visitors of all ages and serves as the base for our conservation, education, and advocacy work.

With over 400 acres, and miles of marked trails, Broad Meadow Brook is the largest urban wildlife sanctuary in New England, and serves as a visitor information center for the John H. Chafee Blackstone River Valley National Heritage Corridor.

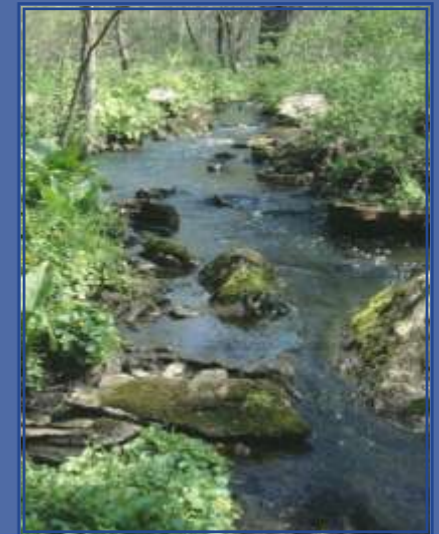
As conservation advocates, we develop programs that educate and assist citizens, civic leaders, municipal officials, legislators, community groups, teachers and students to protect vital natural resources. We lead efforts to protect water resources, key open space and park lands; promote recycling and waste reduction, and with the help of a strong citizens' network, support significant conservation legislation and local initiatives.

Environmental education at Broad Meadow Brook emphasizes hands-on, joyful learning experiences at all levels. Programs are offered year-round to people of all ages, from preschoolers to seniors. Lectures, slide shows and special programs are shared with schools, scouts, homeschooling families and garden clubs. Our vacation and summer camps educate and entertain kids of all ages. In addition, we provide programming at many local community centers, offer a free summer parks program, as well as free canoe rides on local ponds.
