Scheduling a Program

When can I schedule a program?

Days

We schedule programs for Saturdays, starting at 10:00 am, and weekdays after school. Sundays are available depending on instructor availability. We are closed Mondays.

Time

All programs must end by 5:00 p.m., unless it is an evening program.

Where are programs held?

The majority of our programs take place outside, so please dress appropriately. If weather makes outdoor activities unsafe, we will modify or reschedule the program.

What are the program fees?

Day programs

Up to 2 hrs

\$70.00 first 8 youth, plus 2 chaperones
Each additional child or adult is \$7.00

3 hours

\$80.00 first 8 youth, plus 2 chaperones
Each additional child or adult is \$8.00

Evening programs (1.5 hours)

\$95.00 first 8 youth, plus 2 chaperones
Each additional child or adult is \$9.50
