## Scheduling a Program

### When can I schedule a program?

#### Days

We schedule programs for Saturdays, starting at 10:00 am, and weekdays after school. We are closed Mondays, and do not lead groups on Sundays.

#### Time

All programs must end by 5:00 p.m., unless it is an evening program.

### Where are programs held?

The majority of our programs take place outside, so please dress appropriately. If weather makes outdoor activities unsafe, we will modify or reschedule the program.

### What are the program fees?

#### Day programs

*Up to 2 hrs*

\$70.00 first 8 youth, plus 2 chaperones  
Each additional child or adult is \$7.00

*3 hours*

\$80.00 first 8 youth, plus 2 chaperones  
Each additional child or adult is \$8.00

#### Evening programs (1.5 hours)

\$95.00 first 8 youth, plus 2 chaperones  
Each additional child or adult is \$9.50
