Refund/Cancellation: if you wish to cancel your child's enrollment in a session, you must notify the camp 3 weeks prior to the beginning of the session in order to receive a fifty percent refund of the total camp payment (minus the registration fee). The registration fee is non-refundable. No rebates will be given for incomplete attendance. We reserve the right to cancel a session due to low enrollment. In this event, a full refund would be given.
