Awesome Amphibians July 12-16

They are slimy yet cute, and our sanctuary is their home. Explore the vernal pool and forest, looking for sticky-tongued frogs and shiny salamanders. Create art inspired by these amazing amphibians, and learn to play the fly-catching game.

Super Heroes of the Sky July 19-23

Let's take a closer look at creatures of the air like dragonflies, falcons and hawks. We'll search for insects in the field, explore their super senses and make our own amazing flying creatures.

Scales and Tails July 12-16

Venture into the surprising world of reptiles and amphibians. Look closely at how they move and discover where they live. Make life-size tortoises, incredibly long snakes and tiny frogs. Visit the stream and vernal pool, and play leap-frog and alligator tag.

Soaring Raptors July 19-23

What's it like to be a hawk, an owl or an eagle? We'll compare our senses to raptors', learn to hoot like an owl and play games like predator/prey. And we'll create giant wings, eagle kites and owl puppets with moving heads.

Magic Mud EXT. DAY OPTION July 26-30

Wild and Funny VISITING ARTIST July 5-9

Design funny animal characters and create stories about them. Learn cartooning with a cartoon artist. Our days will also include playing games and getting inspiration from visits to the field, forest and wetland.
