

Girl Scout Programs

Afterschool Programs (Fee: \$7.50 per girl)

Let's Go Letterboxing! (ages 8 and up)

Dates: October 5-9, 3:45-5:30 pm*

Hidden at Habitat are letterboxes created for this program! We'll use maps, compasses, and orienteering skills to figure out the puzzles and clues that will lead to the secret spot.

Maple Sugaring (ages 5 and up)

Dates: Weekdays, February 25-March 12, 3:45-5:15 pm*

Come learn about the science and history of sugaring through hands-on activities, exhibits, and a visit to a tapped tree. We'll even boil down and sample some of the sap.

Magical Spring Pools (ages 5 and up)

Dates: April 12-16, 3:45-5:15 pm*

What are those magical ponds that appear for only a short time in the spring? We will visit a vernal pool and collect amphibians and insects to observe, identify and release.

Secret Life of Redbacks (ages 8 and up)

Dates: May 3-7, 3:45-5:15 pm*

Redback salamanders are one of the many hidden creatures on our forest floors. We'll explore secret places and see what we find. Each troop will build observation skills while collecting and recording data of the day's discoveries.

Outdoor Adventurer

Date: Saturday, November 7, 1:00-3:00 pm

Use your senses to discover the different textures, shapes, colors, smells and sounds in nature. Learn how to dress for the weather and to build a shelter.

Space Explorers

Date: Saturday, November 14, 6:00-8:00 pm

Explore the night sky. Learn about constellations, the North Star and phases of the moon while using a telescope.

Earth is Our Home

Date: Saturday, January 9, 10:00-noon OR 1:00-3:00 pm

How do you show you care for your Mother Earth? Learn how to stop cold drafts, create your own natural cleaners and the best things to recycle.

Me and My Shadow

Date: Saturday, January 30, 10:00-noon OR 1:00-3:00 pm

Have you created shadow puppets with your hands? Learn how light is used to create the changing shapes of shadows.

Science Wonders

Junior Badge Workshops (Fee: \$15.00 per girl)

Sky Search

Date: Saturday, November 7, 5:30-8:30 pm

Investigate the sky at night. Listen to ancient myths about the constellations and create your own. Learn neat facts about the moon and its phases. This is an evening program.

Hiker

Date: Saturday, November 14, 1:00-4:30 pm

What do you need to know to prepare for a hike? We'll prepare for any weather and spend time exploring Habitat. *Troops must plan at least one other hike on their own to complete this badge.*

Wildlife

Date: Saturday, January 23, 9:00am-12:30 pm OR 1:30-5:00 pm

Examine the classes of animals and their adaptations, while visiting Habitat's resident animals. Learn about endangered species and discuss ways to help them.

Frosty Fun

Date: Saturday, February 6, 9:00am-12:30 pm OR 1:30-5:00 pm

How do people and animals adapt to the winter? Learn about cold weather injuries and what to do to prevent them. Investigate the grounds for signs of animals, while snowshoeing.

Finding Your Way

What would you do if you got lost? Learn how to read different types of maps, use a compass and create maps and trails.

Eco-Action (ages 11-17)
