Let's Explore - An hour-long guided natural history hike exploring the season, different habitats, and searching for signs of wildlife. (Fee Level A)

Nature Tales - A nature storybook reading followed by a guided nature hike (see above). (Fee Level A)

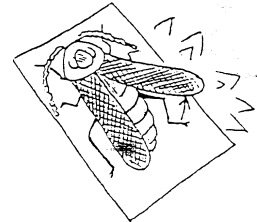
Nature Games - Learn about animal survival and adaptations by playing camouflage and predator/prey games. Trail games and other activities may be included during a hike. (Fee Level A)



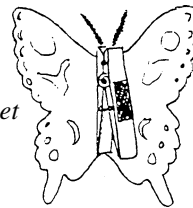
Crafty Critters - Create a simple party-favor craft and follow it up with an outdoor exploration hike. Choose one craft design below. (Fee Level B)



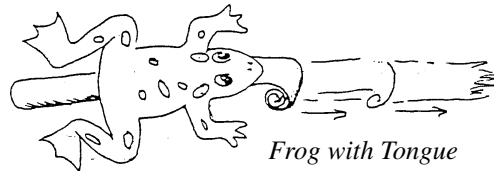
Mammal Mask

All parties have an outdoor component. Parties are NOT canceled due to rain. We will go out rain, snow or shine to explore the beauty of the landscape and its creatures. Please ensure your guests are dressed for the weather, remember good shoes are a must. We will not go out in thunderstorms, hail, or other severe weather conditions.

Moose Hill provides:

- ◆ Program Leader and materials for 1 hr.
- ◆ Set up of table and chairs and clean up.
- ◆ Refrigerator and kitchen facilities

You are responsible for:

- ◆ Table clothes, party supplies, decorations, refreshments
- ◆ Ensuring guests arrive on time
- ◆ Supervising children during second hour of your visit
- ◆ Removal of your trash

Fee Level A


Cost per child: \$10 member /\$13 non-member


Fee Level B

Cost per child: \$11 member /\$14 non-member

 Our recommended maximum is 14 children. If you have more, let us know. Your party space will just be a bit tight.

 There is a \$100 minimum fee.

 A non-refundable deposit of \$100 is required to confirm the date and time of your birthday party and should be received within one week after scheduling your birthday party by phone.

 The balance is due the day of your party and is based on the actual number of participants there that day.


Moose Hill Wildlife Sanctuary

Moose Hill Wildlife Sanctuary, located in Sharon and established in 1916, is the oldest Massachusetts Audubon Society sanctuary and one of the oldest private wildlife sanctuaries in the United States. Moose Hill protects nearly 2,000 acres of forests, fields, and wetland habitats. The Sanctuary offers a wide variety of programs and services for children, adults, families, schools, scouts and community groups. The office and gift shop are open weekdays from 9 to 5 and weekends from 10 to 4. Spring/Summer parking lot/trail hours are daily from 7 to 7. Fall/Winter parking lot/trail hours are 8 to 5. Members hike for free. The trail fee for non-members is \$4 for adults and \$3 for children and seniors. Children three and under are free.
