

## Discovery Programs

Discover the wonders of Moose Hill during a special program just for your MOMS Club or play group. Each program is 60 minutes and includes stories, games, usually a craft, and indoor circle time. Each month offers a new seasonal topic to explore. Outdoor exploration may be included depending on the weather and theme. Activities are geared for children ages 3 and 4, but all ages are welcomed to attend. The class is limited to 15 participating children, no matter what their age, and their accompanying adult. Younger children not participating are welcome to attend when supervised by an adult.

February - Owls or Groundhogs



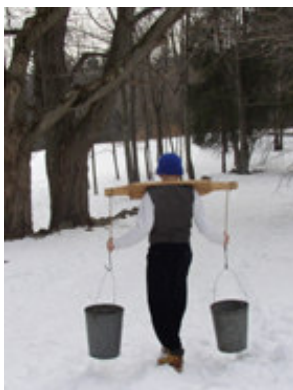
March - Maple Sugaring or Windy Days

Adults are free.

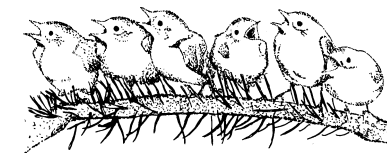

## Drop-Off Program for Children Age 3 and 4

### Knee-High Naturalists

This is a drop-off program where your 3- or 4-year old child can explore the wonders of Moose Hill once a week, all season long. Each week will offer a new nature or science-related theme to explore and discover through games, songs, art, and outdoor, hands-on/minds-on experiences. We want to encourage young children to enjoy and explore the outdoors through games and other safe learning experiences and help them to establish a lasting relationship with the natural world. Children have the freedom to play and interact with their environment under the guidance of trained staff. We are offering two identical sessions scheduled on Mondays and Tuesdays from 9:30 a.m. to 12 noon. Call or stop by for a brochure listing dates, fees, and other details. If a session has already started, we can prorate the fees.



### *Moose Hill Wildlife Sanctuary*

Moose Hill Wildlife Sanctuary, located in Sharon and established in 1916, is the oldest Massachusetts Audubon Society sanctuary and one of the oldest private wildlife sanctuaries in the United States. Moose Hill protects nearly 2,000 acres of forests, fields and wetland habitats. The Sanctuary offers a wide variety of programs and services for children, adults, families, schools, scouts and community groups. The office and gift shop is open weekdays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m and weekends from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Members hike for free. The trail fee for non-members is \$4 for adults and \$3 for children and seniors. Children three and under are free.
