

DIRECTIONS TO OAK KNOLL:

From 495: Exit at 95S and follow to Exit 5. Take a left off the ramp and bear right at the first set of lights. Follow straight into Downtown Attleboro. Take a left at the lights in the center of Attleboro and follow signs to La Salette Shrine. The sanctuary is located 1/2 mile on the right after La Salette Shrine.

From 95 North or South: Take Exit 5. Take a left off the ramp and bear right at the first set of lights. Follow straight into Downtown Attleboro. Take a left at the lights in the center of Attleboro and follow signs to La Salette Shrine. The sanctuary is located 1/2 mile on the right after La Salette Shrine.

RENTAL INFORMATION

Thank you for your interest in holding a function at Oak Knoll Wildlife Sanctuary!

The Sanctuary building houses nature exhibits, an art gallery, and a natural history library. Guests are welcome to enjoy Oak Knoll's trails and grounds during breaks, or before or after the event.

Groups may schedule a sanctuary tour or an educational program on natural history topics for an additional fee. Please contact the sanctuary for more information on scheduling.

Rental time must include set-up and clean up. The arrival of caterers, equipment, etc... must be scheduled at least one week in advance. An additional charge of \$50 per half hour will be assessed if guests remain after the pre-arranged rental period.

Oak Knoll encourages the use of ecologically-friendly decorations, plates and utensils, and other party supplies. Please contact us for help planning a "greener" event.

EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES:
