

2020 Financial Aid Program

We are pleased to offer financial aid to eligible applicants. **Please read the following information before completing a financial aid application.** Contact the Wildwood Office at 866-627-2267 if you have questions.

How does Wildwood decide who receives financial aid?

Any family may apply for financial aid. We review applications in the order that they are received, please allow at least two weeks for processing. Only completed applications with all attachments will be reviewed. Aid may be awarded for <u>one session per camper</u>, <u>per summer</u>. Financial Aid may be used toward any session - Family Camp, ELP, overnight camp, and trips. We consider each family's income and size, as well as extenuating circumstances. Wildwood does not award full tuition; families are requested to provide at least 20% of tuition. All financial aid is distributed at the discretion of the Wildwood Director in accordance with Mass Audubon policy.

Does Wildwood guarantee financial aid?

Wildwood does not guarantee that a particular camper or family will receive financial aid. If a camper has received aid before, we cannot guarantee support at the same level the next summer.

We review applications in the order they are received. Apply as soon as you know you want to send a camper to Wildwood. If we receive a financial aid application after the budgeted aid has been awarded or after your desired session has filled, we will let you know and will keep your application on file to be reconsidered if another family has a change of plans and more aid or space becomes available.

Where does Wildwood get funds to award as financial aid?

The majority of the financial aid awarded by Wildwood is unfunded. This means that most money awarded as financial aid is taken directly from our operating budget, so this amount is necessarily limited.

However, we are fortunate to receive a small amount of dedicated financial aid from:

- Donations made to the Kids to Camp scholarship fund
- Camp store balances that are donated to be used for financial aid
- Occasional grants, for which we must apply annually
- Memorial funds and endowments

Some additional ideas for financing:

Register early: We accept registrations for the next summer as soon as the current camp season begins.

Become a Mass Audubon member: Mass Audubon membership at the family level or higher at the time of registration entitles you to a member price on camp programs. You pay the membership fee only once a year, no matter how many programs members of your family attend. A grandparent's membership at the family level or higher earns the member price for a grandchild's camp registration. If you are not a Mass Audubon member when you apply for financial aid, Wildwood may include a membership in your financial aid offer, so you can receive aid based on the member price for your camp session.

Ask about a payment plan: We can work with you to set up a payment plan that meets your family's needs, as long as camp tuition is paid in full at least two weeks before camp. Please speak to us to set up a payment plan.

Plan now for a future session: A family camp session or one-week session can provide a camp experience this summer and allow you to budget for a longer camp experience next summer.

Explore community resources: There may be funds available from schools and parent organizations, United Way chapters, service or environmental clubs, or other community resources that can help you reduce the cost of camp for your family. Families find aid through these avenues each year.
