## Program Example Drawing

During this 2 hour program, juniors will

- Visit our art museum and take a behind the scenes tour of our art collection. They will look closely at amazing drawings and paintings.
- Collect natural materials on a hike to create a still life and draw with different drawing materials.
- Draw an outdoor scene at the wildlife sanctuary and learn how to use shading.
- Draw a wildlife cartoon inspired by the still life, outdoor sketch, and hike.

This program will allow each junior to complete badge steps 1-4, with the option of hosting an art show for the troop in our estate house to complete step 5. Each junior will take home 1-4 pieces of art.

Mass Audubon's Museum of American Bird Art specializes in providing outdoor and indoor environmental, art, and science programs for Girl Scouts. Our programs have been designed by highly qualified art, nature, and environmental educators or artists and cover badge requirements for the Girl Scouts USA. Some badge programs can be combined. For example, the flowers and detective program can be combined in a single program to complete most steps needed to acquire each badge. Cost for a natural history program is \$80 minimum, \$10 per junior, and cost for an art intensive badge program is \$150 minimum, \$15 per junior. Discounts are available for multiple badge and journey programs.
