# SENGEKONTACKET NEST SURVEYS

*Call Felix Neck to sign up. Bring a piece of paper & pen/pencil*

- Purpose: snapshot of how many crabs are nesting at Sengekontacket
- When: 8am the day after DMF night surveys
- Where: Sengekontacket Pond side of State Beach, Edgartown, MA
- How: Record location and length of beach surveyed.
  - Entryway posts to Nantucket side of State Beach have numbers on them; or mark a Google Earth map
  - Look for nests along the pond side of the beach, tally on the front of this sheet. Also note any crabs if seen
