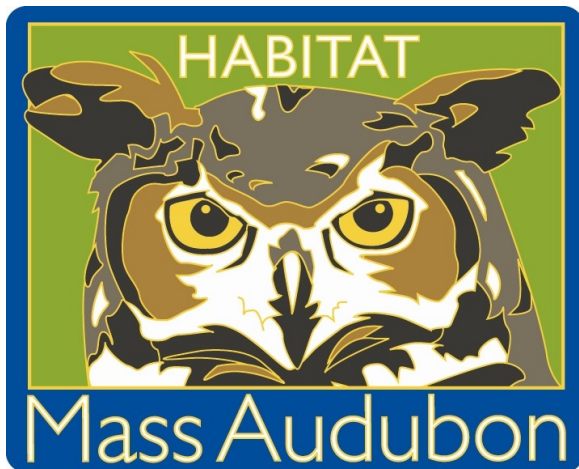




# Birthday Parties

Celebrate your birthday at Habitat. Habitat offers birthday parties from September to May. The programs are designed for children turning 6 to 10 years old. Once all of your guests have arrived, our experienced staff will lead the children in a 60 minute program, which always includes some time outside. We provide 2 teachers to lead a maximum of 15 children in a single group. After some exploring, your guests will return to the library where you may serve refreshments.

## To Schedule a Party

Parties are held on weekday afternoons from 3:30-5:30 pm or on weekends from 10:00 am-12:00 pm or 2:00-4:00 pm. **Parties must be booked at least three weeks in advance.** A Mass Audubon family membership and non-refundable deposit of \$50 is required to schedule a birthday party. No program is confirmed until the deposit is received.

Pre-registration is required for all programs. There is a maximum of 15 children at the party. We also ask that at least two adults accompany the children and Habitat staff during the program. Parties featuring live animals are an additional \$25.

How are animals preparing for winter? Build a mouse house.

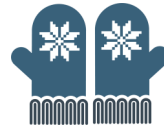
## Winter
