



Paint the Snow

Fresh snow is the perfect backdrop for some snow painting. You can draw, spray, or squirt different colors to make messages, colorful scenes, or even animals. Using non-toxic tempera paint or diluted food coloring in squirt or spray bottles will allow your "inner artist" to emerge this winter!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 3-6 clear squirt bottles or spray bottles
- 3-6 non-toxic tempera paints or bottles of food coloring (assorted colors)
- tap water
- optional: different size paint brushes

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fill your containers with tap water until they are almost full.
2. Add several drops of your paint or food coloring.
3. Put the cap on tight and shake it. Do you want a brighter color? Add some more!
4. After all your bottles are filled, make sure the tops are on tight.
5. Choose a clean patch of snow where you can paint.
6. Try to space out your drawings, don't make them too big and make them colorful.
7. Made a mistake? No problem! Just cover it with snow and start again.
