#### Directions:

##### **From Vineyard Haven/Tisbury and the Vineyard Haven ferry**

Follow State Road and turn left onto the Edgartown/Vineyard Haven Road. Proceed approximately 5 miles and look for the Mass Audubon sign on the left that marks the entrance to Felix Neck Drive. Turn left onto Felix Neck Drive and travel 0.75 of a mile to the parking lot and follow the path to the nature center.

##### **From Edgartown**

Follow the Edgartown/Vineyard Haven Road from the Edgartown Triangle area (landmarks are the Edgartown Post Office, Granite/Ace Hardware) and proceed approximately 2 miles. On the right you will see a Mass Audubon sign at Felix Neck Drive. Turn right onto Felix Neck Drive and travel 0.75 of a mile to the parking lot and follow the path to the nature center.

##### **From Oak Bluffs**

Take County Road until it intersects with the Edgartown/Vineyard Haven Road. Turn left onto Edgartown/Vineyard Haven Road and follow for 2 miles until you see a Mass Audubon sign on your left at Felix Neck Drive. Turn onto Felix Neck Drive and travel 0.75 of a mile to the parking lot and follow the path to the nature center.

##### **From West Tisbury**

Take the Edgartown/West Tisbury Road towards Edgartown. Turn left on to Barnes Road (just past the airport entrance) until it intersects with Edgartown/Vineyard Haven Road at the roundabout. Turn right and continue for 2 miles until you see a Mass Audubon sign on your left at Felix Neck Drive.

Turn left onto Felix Neck Drive and travel 0.75 of a mile to the parking lot. Follow the path to the Nature Center.

### **From Chilmark and Aquinnah**

Take South Road and turn right onto Edgartown/West Tisbury Road towards Edgartown. Turn left on to Barnes Road (just past the airport entrance) until it intersects with Edgartown/Vineyard Haven Road at the roundabout. Turn right and continue for 2 miles until you see a Mass Audubon sign on your left at Felix Neck Drive. Turn left onto Felix Neck Drive and travel  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile to the parking lot. Follow the path to the Nature Center.

### **Martha's Vineyard Transit Authority**

Public bus schedules are available at the ferry terminal, information booths, and Chamber of Commerce; take bus #1.

*Please note:* Bicycles are permitted on the entrance trail but must be left in the parking area.

### **Directions:**

Cross the Sagamore Bridge onto Cape Cod. Take Rt 6 east toward Hyannis. At exit 6, take Rt 132 south to Hyannis and follow signs for the Nantucket boats (Steamship Authority or Hyline).

### **From the Steamship Authority Wharf on Nantucket:**

From the parking lot follow Broad Street and turn left onto South Water Street. Continue across Main Street onto Washington Street. Turn right onto Francis Street, left onto Union Street, and then left onto Orange Street. At the rotary, take Sparks Avenue. Stay on Sparks Avenue through the next rotary and after 0.4 miles take a left on Surfside Road, and then an immediate right onto Vesper Lane. Take a left onto Hummock Pond Road and follow for nearly 1.5 miles. Less than 1000 feet past 167Raw, look for a gravel parking lot on the right. This parking lot is owned and maintained by the Nantucket Land Bank and used by the public to access the Land Bank's Gardner Farm property as

well as Mass Audubon's adjoining Lost Farm property which share a trail system. Follow trail signs to access Lost Farm.

**From the Straight Wharf on Nantucket:** Follow Main Street for 0.25 miles and take a left onto Washington Street. Follow directions above "From the Steamship Authority Wharf."

### Directions:

Cross the Sagamore Bridge onto Cape Cod. Take Rt 6 east toward Hyannis. At exit 6, take Rt 132 south to Hyannis and follow signs for the Nantucket boats (Steamship Authority or Hyline).

**From the Steamship Authority Wharf on Nantucket:** From the parking lot follow Broad Street and turn left onto South Water Street. Continue across Main Street onto Washington Street. Turn right onto Francis Street, left onto Union Street, and then left onto Orange Street. At the rotary, take Milestone Road. After 0.5 miles bear left onto Polpis Road and follow for nearly 6 miles. Less than 1 mile past Sesachacha Pond, look for Barnard Valley Road (dirt road) on the right (opposite Hoicks Hollow Road). The sanctuary is directly off Barnard Valley Road.

**From the Straight Wharf on Nantucket:** Follow Main Street for 0.25 miles and take a left onto Washington Street. Follow directions above "From the Steamship Authority Wharf."

**From Rt 3 or Rt I-495 south:** Cross over the Bourne Bridge. After the bridge, go around the rotary and follow Rt 28 south toward Falmouth. At the intersection of Rt 28 and Rt 151 in North Falmouth, take a right onto Rt 151 east and follow it for 4 miles. Turn left on Currier Road and then take the first right onto Ashumet Road. The sanctuary entrance is the first left.

**From the Mashpee rotary:** Take Rt 151 west for 3 miles. Turn right onto Currier Road and take the first right onto Ashumet Road. The sanctuary entrance is the first left.

**By public transportation:** Public Transportation is available through the Cape Cod Regional Transport Authority (CCRTA). From the Mid-Cape Highway (Route 6) take exit 68 (formerly exit 6) on to Route 132 North. Follow to Route 6A in Barnstable and take a right. Travel one mile heading east and look for 2444 and the Sanctuary sign on the left just after Barnstable West Barnstable Elementary School entrance. Due to right-of-way restrictions, there is no sanctuary sign visible from the street. Follow driveway to parking area. Parking area can accommodate roughly 4 vehicles, please be courteous and avoid blocking private driveways.

### Directions:

Cross the Sagamore Bridge onto Cape Cod. From Route 6, take exit 27 (formerly exit 7) to Yarmouth Port. Go north one mile on Willow Street, and take a left onto Route 6A west. Proceed for approximately one mile, then take a right on Bone Hill Road. You'll see a large sign for the Harbor Point Restaurant and a smaller sign for Long Pasture. Follow Bone Hill Road past the upper trail head parking area to the end of Bone Hill Rd and look for a large white Sanctuary sign on your left. Take this driveway to the Visitor Center parking area. Parking is available in the field to your left, and around the circular drive in front of the Visitor Center.

**By public transportation:** Public Transportation is available through the Cape Cod Regional Transport Authority (CCRTA). ### Directions:

Cross the Cape Cod canal via the Sagamore or Bourne bridge. Follow the signs to Rt 6/Mid-Cape Highway. Follow Rt 6 east to exit 65 (formerly exit 5) for Rt 149 south towards Osterville. Follow Rt 149 south for approximately 0.25 miles and bear left onto Osterville/West Barnstable Road. Follow this road for 2.8 miles. From the traffic light on Rt 28, continue on Osterville/West Barnstable Road for 0.5 miles towards Osterville. Take the first left on Bumps River Road. Proceed for 0.7 miles and continue left at the intersection, the sanctuary parking lot is 100 yards on the left.

**From Boston:** Follow Rt 3 south and cross the Sagamore Bridge to Cape Cod. Follow Rt 6 east for 45 miles. The sanctuary entrance is on the left just over the Wellfleet/ Eastham town line after the Wellfleet Drive-in Theater.

**From Providence:** Follow Rt I-195 or Rt I-495 to Rt 25 and cross the Bourne Bridge to Cape Cod. Turn off the Bourne Rotary at the exit for Rt 6 east. Continue on Rt 6 for 50 miles. The sanctuary entrance is on the left just over the Wellfleet/ Eastham town line after the Wellfleet Drive-in Theater.

**From Provincetown:** Take Rt 6 west to South Wellfleet. The sanctuary entrance is on the right just before the Wellfleet Drive-in Theater.

**By public transportation:** Public Transportation is available through the Cape Cod Regional Transport Authority (CCRTA). #### Directions:

##### To Sanctuary Entrance at Field Station:

From Interstate 195, in Westport, take exit 16 (Rt 88 South). Follow Route 88 through three lights to intersection with Hixbridge Rd at 4th light. Turn left onto Hixbridge Rd and proceed 1.8 miles to stop sign at Pine Hill Rd and Horseneck Rd. Turn right onto Horseneck Rd and proceed nearly to the ocean for 4.8 miles. Sanctuary parking is on your left just past Bayside Restaurant and adjacent to our Field Station at 1280 Horseneck Rd.

##### To Sanctuary Entrance at Stone Barn Farm

From Interstate 195, in Westport, take exit 16 (Rt 88 South). Follow Route 88 for 7.2 miles through three lights to intersection with Hixbridge Rd at 4th light. Turn left onto Hixbridge Rd and proceed 1.5 miles to stop sign at Pine Hill Rd and Horseneck Rd. Turn right onto Horseneck Rd. Proceed 3.3 miles to corner with East Horseneck Rd and turn left. Stone Barn Farm entrance will be 0.4 miles further on your right at 786 E. Horseneck Rd. In Dartmouth

##### To Sanctuary Entrance at Allens Neck

Follow directions to Stone Barn Farm and continue east on E. Horseneck Rd for another 0.7 miles. Turn right onto Allens Neck Rd and proceed 0.4 miles to parking lot on your right. Massachusetts Audubon Society signs are posted.

Pass the La Salette Shrine and take your next right at the stone gatehouse onto Attleboro Springs Road. The sanctuary is located at the end of the road, you may follow the Mass Audubon signs.

Stay left on Rt 6 over bridge to light. Turn right onto Narrows Road. Take 2nd right onto Indian Neck Road, which becomes RD Stillman Memorial Drive. At the T-intersection, turn right onto Great Neck Road and follow for 1.4 miles. Turn right onto Stockton Shortcut and keep straight (becomes unpaved after Little Harbor Country Club) to parking lot on right.

**From Rt 3A:** Take a right onto Mayflower Street at the Duxbury Fire Station. From Rt 3A north, take a left onto Mayflower Street. Sanctuary parking is 1.2 miles ahead on the right.

#### From the North

Take MA-3 S to Exit 12 for Plimoth Plantation Hwy in Plymouth. Follow Plimoth Plantation Hwy for 1.7 miles until it turns into MA-3A S. Continue on MA-3A S for 2.5 miles and turn right onto Beaver Dam Road. The parking lot at 60 Beaver Dam Road will be about 0.6 miles down on the left.

#### From the South

Take Exit 7 (formerly Exit 3) from MA-3 N. Turn right onto Clark Road. In 0.7 miles, Clark Road becomes Beaver Dam Road. The parking lot at 60 Beaver Dam Road is 2.5 miles down on the right.

**From Rt I-495:** Take exit 15 (Rt 1A). Follow Rt 1A north for 4 miles to the intersection of Rt 1A and Rt 115 in Norfolk. Turn left and follow Rt 115 north for 1.5 miles and turn left onto North Street. The sanctuary is a few hundred feet ahead on the right.

**From Rt I-95 north:** Take exit 9 (Rt 1). Follow Rt 1 south for approximately 5 miles (pass the Gillette Stadium on the left). At the intersection of Rt 1 and Pine

Street (at a traffic light), turn right onto Pine Street. At the end of Pine Street, turn right on Rt 115 north. After 2.5 miles, turn left onto North Street. The sanctuary is a few hundred feet ahead on the right.

Take I-90 towards Boston/NH/Maine. Follow I-90 East until Exit 14: I-95/Route 128. Merge onto I-95 South. Take Exit 20A: Route 9 East towards Boston/Brookline. Follow the directions immediately below: “From the West.”

#### From the West:

Take Route 9 East to Route 1 South, the Jamaica way. Continue straight onto Jamaica way/Riverway. Pass Jamaica Pond and use any lane to turn slightly right onto Arborway. Use the left 2 lanes to stay on Arborway. Continue straight to stay on Arborway. At traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto MA-203E/Arborway. Pass the Arnold Arboretum and bear slight right to take the MA-203E exit. Turn right onto Washington Street. Turn left onto Ukraine Way. Turn right onto Hyde Park Ave. Turn left onto Walk Hill Street. Continue on Walk Hill Street and cross over American Legion Highway. Take the first left at the sign for Boston Nature Center. Go straight at the intersection and continue until you see our parking lot and large yellow building.

**From the North:**

Take Route 93 South (through Boston) until you see the South Bay Mall on your right. Take Exit 15: Columbia Road/JFK. Take right at bottom of ramp onto Columbia Road. Columbia Road will bear to the left at the intersection of Mass Ave. and Boston Street. Follow Columbia Road until it intersects with Blue Hill Avenue. (Franklin Park Zoo will be across the street.) Turn left on Blue Hill Avenue; get into the right lane and follow to the intersection of American Legion Highway (at Mobil Station). Turn right onto American Legion Highway. At the fourth set of lights (look for the Wendy’s), turn left onto Walk Hill Street. Take the first left at the sign for Boston Nature Center. Go straight at the intersection and continue until you see our parking lot and large yellow building.
