Locally, your sponsorship helps:

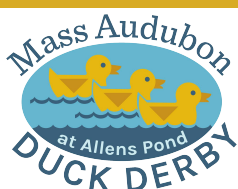
- Protect nesting sites at Allens Pond for threatened Piping Plovers and American Oystercatchers.
- Restore and monitor South Coast salt marshes that buffer communities from storms.
- Engage local volunteers and families in hands-on stewardship and education.

Statewide, your impact ripples even further. In 2024, Mass Audubon:

- Protected 379 pairs of Piping Plovers—32% of the state's population.
- Partnered with 43 municipalities to safeguard 141 miles of shoreline.
- Increased American Oystercatcher abundance by 21%.

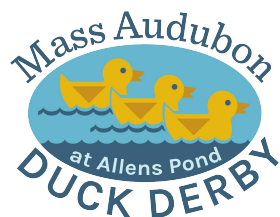

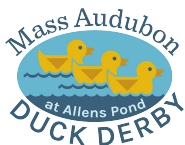
