

Camping at Perkins Island Rules and Regulations

For the health and safety of campers and habitat, all campers must abide by the following set of regulations, which are in addition to our [standard sanctuary rules](#).

- Camp only at your assigned site and always carry camping permit.
- Only set fires in assigned fire pits; please extinguish all fires with water.
- Only use firewood supplied by sanctuary staff and/or purchased at check in.
- Carry out what you carry in; remove all waste from the sanctuary. Human waste including toilet paper should be carried in a landfill-safe toilet bag provided upon check in.
- Only use Mass Audubon provided canoes; no private boats allowed. Canoes may not enter Bunker Meadows.
- All persons must always wear a USCG-rated Level III Personal Floatation Device (PFD) for the appropriate size/weight while in a canoe.
- Please leave dogs and other pets at home ([service animals welcome](#))
- No fishing, swimming, or feeding wildlife.
- No drugs, alcohol, smoking, fireworks, and firearms.
- Quiet hours are 10:00 pm to 7:00 am; please be considerate of other campers by keeping the noise level down; headset radios only.
