Moose Hill protects nearly 2000 acres of forests, fields, and wetland habitats. Discovery Programs

Discover the wonders of Moose Hill during a special program just for your MOMS Club or play group. Each program is about 60 minutes and includes stories, games, usually a craft, indoor circle time, and outdoor exploration, depending on the weather and your group's interest.

Each month offers a new seasonal topic to explore. Activities are geared for children ages 3 and 4, but all ages are welcomed to attend.

The class is limited to 15 participating children, no matter what their age, and their accompanying adult. Younger children not participating are welcome to attend when supervised by an adult.

Knee-High Naturalists Science Enrichment for Preschoolers

This drop-off program is where your 3- or 4-year old child can explore the wonders of Moose Hill once a week, all season long. Each week offers a new nature or science-related theme to explore and discover through games, songs, art, and outdoor, hands-on/ minds-on experiences. We encourage young children to enjoy and explore the outdoors through games and other safe learning experiences and help them to establish a lasting relationship with the natural world. Children have the freedom to play and interact with their environment under the guidance of trained staff.

We offer identical sessions scheduled on Mondays and Tuesdays from 9:30am to 12 noon, September through May.
